

Camp Verde FFA Point of Awards

What is the Chapter FFA Point of Awards?

- The Point of Awards is not to be confused with your FFA participation grade. The point of awards is designed to reward our most active members with a fun activity for their choosing to be an active member in the Camp Verde FFA Chapter. It can lead to a lot of fun and you can earn extra-credit points to be applied to your semester final.

How does it Work?

- When you participate in a FFA Chapter Activity you earn points, you can earn more points by doing additional things at that FFA activity. For example, if you attend a FFA meeting you earn 5 points toward the point of awards. By wearing your FFA jacket and official dress you earn 25 points. For attending all 10 meeting you earn an additional 100 points. At the meeting if you volunteer for a committee you receive an additional 25 points.

What reward do I earn for my participation?

- After the December meeting the list will be finalized for the Winter top 15 trip. This year we are going snow tubing in the mountains. To be eligible to attend the trip you need to finish in the top 25 and to be assured a spot you need to finish in the top 15 of the chapter's membership. Remember for this trip it costs you nothing; it is a reward for your hard work.
- After the May Banquet the list will be totaled and the top 10 point earners who are not the newly elected or past officers will qualify to attend the Chapter FFA Summer Camp. Any member that finishes in the top 25 of the point of awards will be qualified to go to the State Leadership Camp and next years National FFA Convention.

What am I responsible for to have my earned points recorded after I have earned them?

- After each event you attend you need to fill out an event attendance slip documenting your points and turn it in to your teacher. Watch the Chapter's Point of Awards, updated every other week, and make sure your points are correct. If there is an incorrect total it is your responsibility to let your teacher know. Note: Mistakes are made, it is not intentional and if you approach your teacher disrespectfully you will forfeit your points.

Where do I find the value and amount of points for the Chapter Point of Awards program?

- The activities and their value are listed on the back of this page. Pick up a Point Documentation Form in front of the classroom and write down the activity and what your points for that activity are. Have another member or an officer document that your points are correct and sign your form. Turn your form into your FFA Advisor for full credit.
