

## GENERAL RULES FOR FFA/PALS FAIR EXHIBITORS

1. Because of the importance of scholastic achievement, the CVHS Ag. Department requires its livestock exhibitors to maintain a satisfactory scholastic record in his/her classes. Therefore, if any exhibitor fails to meet this requirement, he/she may lose their show privileges.
2. All exhibitors are to follow the directions and advice given to them by the designated advisor for that species. The advisor's directions are to be followed for the whole length of time the project is eligible for show and during the fairs when the project is being exhibited.
3. FFA and PALS members are required to obtain their homework from all their teachers in advance of missing school for attending fairs.
4. All exhibitors are expected to haul their animals and tack to the fair unless other arrangements are made with the advisor.
5. All rules and regulations of Camp Verde High School will apply to the students who participate at fairs, since showing is a school activity.
6. Each exhibitor must read and understand the rules and regulations in the Fair's Premium Book.
7. Where dormitories are provided, all FFA and PALS members must sleep in the dorm.
8. Where dormitories are not provided, these procedures should be followed for campsites or motels:
  - a. All Arizona Fairs Exhibitors must complete a camp site reservation form obtained from the Fair, in order to reserve a trailer site at the fairgrounds. This form will include the names of the students residing in the trailer, the trailer license number, and the name of the adult who will be staying to chaperon these exhibitors.
  - b. Each exhibitor will obtain permission from their instructor prior to the fair.
  - c. Approved ADULT supervision is required from 6PM to 7AM.
9. Each exhibitor is responsible for feeding, watering, grooming, and keeping an eye on his or her animals for the entire length of the fair.
10. Each exhibitor is required to serve barn duties as assigned and specified by the advisors.
11. All FFA or PALS exhibitors will be required to wear an official FFA or Camp Verde PALS uniform while showing their own animals or helping others.
  - a. FFA UNIFORMS Boys-black slacks, white shirt, FFA tie and jacket, and dark shoes/boots. Girls-black slacks, white shirt or blouse, FFA scarf and jacket, and dark shoes/boots.
  - b. PALS UNIFORM - Camp Verde PALS Shirt, black pants, and dark shoes/boots.
12. All FFA exhibitors are to attend the awards program at every fair.
13. Market animal exhibitors are required to write "Thank You Letters" to their buyers.
14. All exhibitors must attend assigned meetings by the designated Advisor unless prior arrangements have been made.
15. The advisor of any species will have the authority to take whatever disciplinary action necessary toward any student that fails to comply with the rules.

# CAMP VERDE FFA/PALS SWINE EXHIBITOR FAIR RULES

1. Equipment you will need
  - a. Feed/water pans
  - b. show cane
  - c. Soft nylon brush
  - d. hair conditioner
  - e. Spray bottle
  - f. small hand brush
  - g. Dish soap
  - h. mineral oil
  - i. Alcohol
  - j. baby powder
  - k. Water nozzle and hose
  - l. rags and towels
  - m. Show uniform
  - n. feed for one week
  - o. Tack box (you may share with a friend)
2. Things to do prior to and at the fair
  - a. Wash your pig prior to bringing them to the fair.
  - b. Make arrangements to have your animal and equipment brought to the fairgrounds.
  - c. Make sure your animal is in proper show condition.
3. Things to do at the fair
  - a. Exhibitors are expected to be at the fair for the purpose of preparing their animals to look their best for the show. It must be understood that this requires a great deal of time.
  - b. Pigs must be fed, watered, and exercised prior to 8:00 a.m. for the morning feeding and between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. for the evening feeding.
  - c. Feed and water your pigs in their pen.
  - d. Check your pig regularly throughout the day.
  - e. Exhibitors must be at the fairgrounds no later than 7:00 a.m. and must participate in the morning cleanup (7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.)
  - f. Exhibitors must serve barn duty as assigned by the advisor which includes being in the barn area to keep an eye on all animals and to keep the area clean.
  - g. Exhibitors are required to show in showmanship.
  - h. On show days all exhibitors are expected to stay for the entire show. All exhibitors will help each other and work together. Everyone is on barn duty throughout the shows.
  - i. All exhibitors are required to be present at the awards ceremony.
  - j. All exhibitors will help cleanup on the last day of the fair.
  - k. Each exhibitor is expected to cooperate with a positive attitude.
4. Any students who do not abide by these responsibilities or the general rules may be subject to
  - a. Disciplinary action as deemed appropriate.
  - b. Additional barn duty assignments.
  - c. Removal of animal project from the fairgrounds.
  - d. Forfeiture of the right to sell animal at the auction.
  - e. Loss of showing privileges for the next year.
5. Each exhibitor also agrees to allow any Camp Verde FFA/PALS Advisor to pick up his/her livestock auction check for him/her at any fair.
