

Town of Camp Verde and Youth Group Livestock Application

Recent changes in the town ordinance on the raising of animals within the town limits has led to the adoption of this agreement in order that Youth Groups will still be able to provide real life educational opportunities to their members while respecting their neighbors. This document is an agreement between the student, their parents, the Youth Group Advisor, and the Town of Camp Verde. The student will be allowed to raise their projects without town interference as long as the student and the student's parents agree to all stipulations of this agreement as certified by the local Youth Group Advisor.

Section 1 - Application Process

- Student will fill out a Camp Verde Youth Livestock Project Application.
- Student will sign the commitment and responsibility statement on their supervised agricultural experience project.
- Parents will co-sign that they will be responsible for the student's supervised agriculture experience project.
- Youth Group Advisor will collect applications and approve the student's project.
- A list of all projects will be compiled and then forwarded the Community Director via Email.

Section 2 - Camp Verde Youth Livestock Issue Resolution Outline

1. Documented Issue brought to the attention of Youth Group Advisor.
2. Youth Group Advisor brings to the attention of student the Issue and investigates for merit.
 - a. Visual investigation of students project(s) with documentation to determine how to address the causes of the issue.
 - i. If issue is not warranted the Advisor will document the findings and inform Community Director via email report, no other action will be taken.
 - ii. If issue is warranted the Advisor, will document the problem and along with the student and parents determine a proper solution.
 - b. Determine proper course of action to fix problems and keep the issue from repeating.
 - c. Necessary determined changes will be implemented in a timely manner and documented.
 - d. Place visual and written documentation signed by student, parents, and advisor into student file and project plan.
 - e. If determined to be a serious problem, place student on contract to ensure good relations with neighbors.
 - f. Email a copy of investigation to Community Director to document that problem was addressed and changes were implemented.
3. If problem is persistent, student and parents will have to find an alternative site to house animal.
4. If no effort is made by student and parents to remedy the issue then the livestock will be subject to community and nuisance codes.

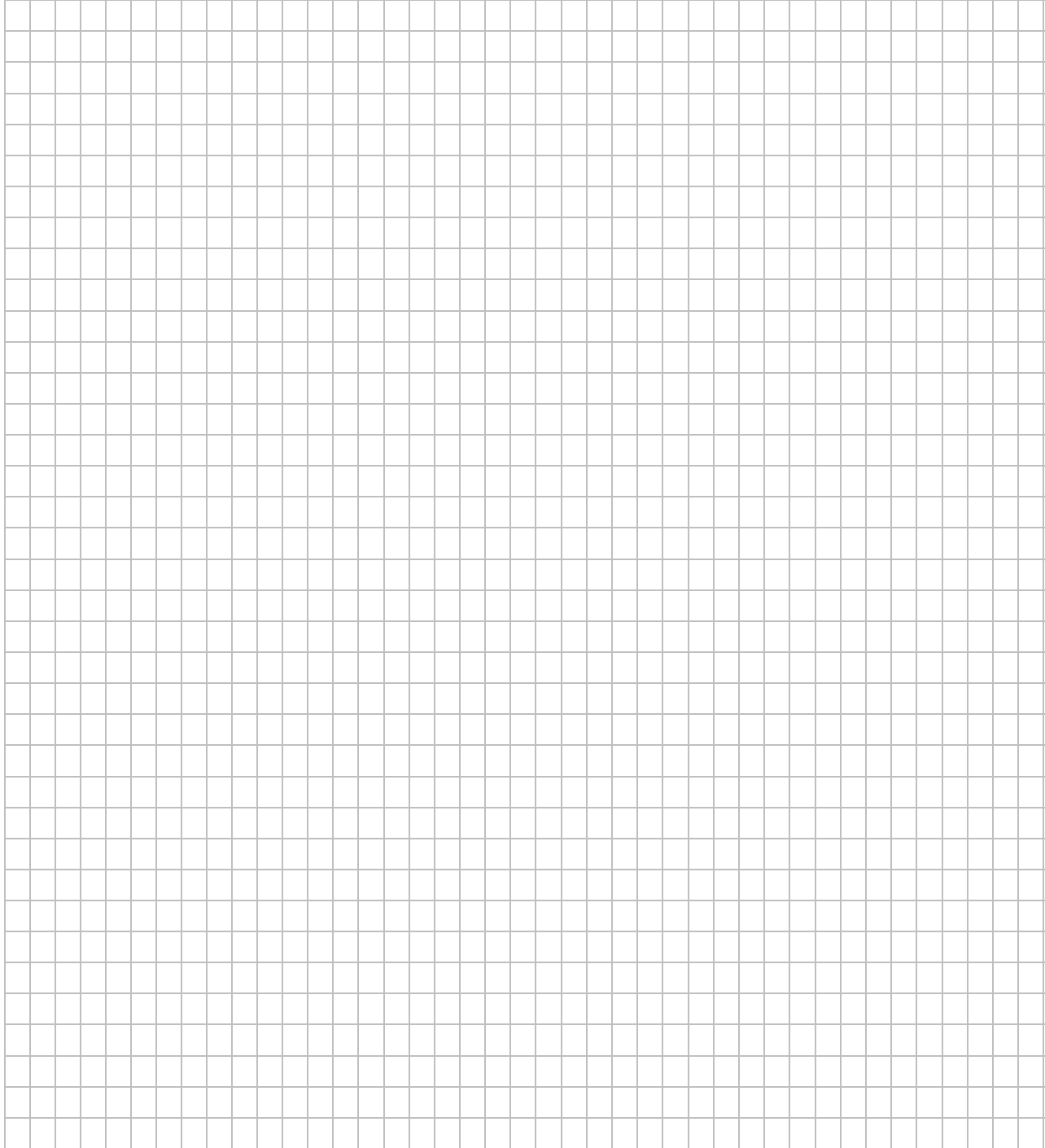
